"God is love" (1 Jn 4: 8) is one of those luminous phrases that, like lightning, are enough to illuminate the whole horizon suddenly. God does not have love properly speaking, but He is love. It is love inwardly, in the trinitarian community: the Father, all of Him, is love to the Son and the Son, all of Him, is love to the Father and the Holy Spirit is the love of the Father and of the Son. God is love also outwardly, to the world and to human beings: John himself says in his Gospel: "God so loved the world that He gave his own Son" (Jn 3,16). REFLECTIONS TO FEED OUR MISSION IN THE WORLD



As members of the Body of Christ we participate in the mission that the Father entrusted to the Son and He, at the same time, entrusted the Church. The resurrected Lord sent from the Father to the Holy Spirit to promote and sustain the Church in her mission. He guides her to the truth, unifies her in communion, and governs and energizes her with multiple gifts. The mission entrusted to the Church is to announce and extend the kingdom of God, that is, to announce salvation in Jesus Christ and to lead men to encounter Him; To develop in the world the seed of the Kingdom to renew men and to make a new humanity, according to the newness of the gospel.
